SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Permits Oregon Department of Administrative Services to study public contracting law. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to public procurement not later than December 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to public contracting. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. The Oregon Department of Administrative Services may study public con-4 tracting law. If the department conducts a study, the department shall submit a report in 5 the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to 6 the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to public procurement no later than December 1, 2023. 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2024. 9
