Senate Bill 440

Sponsored by Senator FERRIOLI (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Department of Education to prepare list related to high-wage and high-demand jobs in state, distribute list to school districts and award grants to school districts to ensure list is distributed to students in grades 9 through 12.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the distribution of job lists to students; and declaring an emergency.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - **SECTION 1. The Department of Education shall:**
- 5 (1) Prepare, in consultation with the Bureau of Labor and Industries and the Higher 6 Education Coordinating Commission, an annual list of:
 - (a) High-wage and high-demand jobs in this state;
 - (b) The projected need for jobs identified under paragraph (a) of this subsection;
 - (c) The projected salary of jobs identified under paragraph (a) of this subsection;
 - (d) The training programs or college programs in this state that can lead to the jobs identified under paragraph (a) of this subsection; and
 - (e) The projected costs associated with the training programs or college programs identified under paragraph (d) of this subsection;
 - (2) Distribute to school districts the list prepared under subsection (1) of this section; and
 - (3) Award grants to school districts to ensure that the list received by the school districts under subsection (2) of this section is distributed to students in grades 9 through 12.

SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, which shall be expended for the purposes described in section 1 of this 2017 Act.

SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.
