Senate Bill 506

Sponsored by Senator LINTHICUM; Senator HANSELL (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Allows counties in eastern Oregon with population less than 50,000 to approve land use applications on certain nonresource, rural lands for industrial or commercial uses that are inconsistent with zoning of such lands.

A BILL FOR AN ACT
Relating to eastern Oregon nonresource lands.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of ORS chapter 197 or 215, and except for rules applicable to areas of critical state concern under ORS 197.405, a county in eastern Oregon, as defined in ORS 321.700, with a population of less than 50,000 may approve a land use application on nonresource lands outside an urban growth boundary for industrial or commercial uses inconsistent with the zoning of the land if the land is composed of Class

VI through Class VIII soils as provided by ORS 215.209 and 215.211.
