Senate Bill 540

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires community college or public university to expel any student convicted of riot.

2	Relating to public post-secondary institution of education response to student conviction for riot.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. A community college district shall expel a student if the student is convicted

5 of the crime of riot under ORS 166.015.

6 SECTION 2. A public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall expel a student if the student

7 is convicted of the crime of riot under ORS 166.015.

8 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Sections 1 and 2 of this 2017 Act apply to convictions for the crime of riot

9 that occur on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.
