SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Chief Education Office for [biennial] expenses incurred in first year of biennium.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocation to Chief Education Office for expenses incurred during second year of biennium.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

Relating to the financial administration of the Chief Education Office; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Chief Education Office, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,022,118 for expenses incurred during the first year of the biennium.

SECTION 2. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,972,118, to be allocated to the Chief Education Office for expenses incurred during the second year of the biennium.

(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2018, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.
