CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Land Conservation and Development; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Department of Land Conservation and Development, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:

- (1) Planning program \$ 11,764,001
- (2) Grant programs \$ 1,583,617

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$1,645,542 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Land Conservation and Development.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$6,530,660 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Land Conservation and Development.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.
