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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Public Defense Services Commission for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by commission.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocation to commission.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

5	SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Public Defense Services Commission, for the

12	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
13	are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payment
14	of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
15	cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Defense Services
16	Commission, for the following purposes:

20	SECTION 3. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
21	priated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General
22	Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000, to be allocated to the Public Defense Services Commission
23	for acquisition of a new financial management system.
