Senate Bill 5538

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Veterans' Affairs for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys for certain purposes.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Oregon War Veterans' Bond Sinking Account, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, for the

biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the
following purposes:

- 11 (2) For payments to counties
- 12 pursuant to ORS 406.462...... \$ 1,874,183
- 13 (3) For payments to veterans'

- 16 (4) For debt service...... \$ 2,249,440

17 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 18 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payment 19 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Veterans' Services Fund established 20 under ORS 406.140 to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, for the following purposes:

(2) For payments to counties
pursuant to ORS 406.462 \$ 7,166,509
(3) For payments to veterans'

3	SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
4	\$104,488,196 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for
5	payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts
6	and the Oregon War Veterans' Bond Sinking Account, but excluding lottery funds and fed-
7	eral funds, collected or received by the Department of Veterans' Affairs for administration,
8	grants and services supplied to veterans.
9	(2) This section does not limit expenditures from the Oregon War Veterans' Bond Sinking
10	Account for purposes described in section 5 of this 2019 Act.
11	SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
12	\$1,525,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for
13	payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Veterans'
14	Affairs.
15	SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, expenditures by the Department
16	of Veterans' Affairs for the following purposes are not limited:
17	(1) Debt service;
18	(2) Professional services and related costs associated directly with bond sales;
19	(3) Loans to veterans; and
20	(4) Payments on behalf of borrowers for property taxes, city liens, fire insurance, mort-
21	gage cancellation insurance and repairs to and miscellaneous charges for borrower-owned
22	property that are charged to the loan account and repaid along with the payment of loan
23	interest and principal.
24	SECTION 6. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
25	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect
26	July 1, 2019.
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
