Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to transfers to the Tobacco Enforcement Fund under ORS 293.537, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall make the following transfers from the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017:

 authorized by ORS 329.501...... \$ 3,564,100

SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.
