## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Makes violation of statutes or rules regarding minimum standards for wine, or branding or labeling requirements for wine, unlawful trade practice.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to unlawful trade practices regarding wine. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 471. SECTION 2. A person engages in an unlawful practice in violation of ORS 646.608 if the 5 6 person violates: 7 (1) ORS 471.442 or 471.446 (2) with regard to wine; (2) Any minimum standards for wine established by rule; or 8 (3) Any branding or labeling requirements for wine established by rule. 9 10
