SUMMARY

Prevents local governments from prohibiting natural gas use in or availability for new or existing residential or commercial buildings.

2	Relating to regulation of natural gas by local governments.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 197.
5	SECTION 2. A local government may not adopt or enforce any ordinance or land use
6	regulation that has the effect of:
7	(1) Prohibiting the installation or use of natural gas in existing or new residential or
8	commercial buildings; or
9	(2) Prohibiting the installation of natural gas infrastructure serving lands zoned to allow
10	for residential or commercial uses.
