Senate Bill 669

SUMMARY

Requires certain mass transit and transportation districts to be registered apprenticeship training agents as condition of receiving distributions from Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 184.752 to
5	184.766.
6	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 184.758, the Oregon Transportation Commission may
7	not distribute moneys in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund to a mass transit
8	district or transportation district with a population of 500,000 or more unless the mass
9	transit district or transportation district is a training agent, as defined in ORS 660.010, at
10	the time of the distribution.
