## Senate Bill 679

Sponsored by Senator BOQUIST (at the request of Matt Dapkus)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits governmental agency or school district from establishing policy regulating, restricting or prohibiting firearms. Provides that policy contrary to prohibition is void.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 166.170 is amended to read:

5 166.170. (1) Except as expressly authorized by state statute, the authority to regulate in any 6 matter whatsoever the sale, acquisition, transfer, ownership, possession, storage, transportation or 7 use of firearms or any element relating to firearms and components thereof, including ammunition, 8 is vested solely in the Legislative Assembly.

9 (2) Except as expressly authorized by state statute, [*no*] **a** county, city or other municipal cor-10 poration or district, governmental agency or school district may not enact or establish civil or 11 criminal ordinances, including but not limited to zoning ordinances, or policies, including em-12 ployment policies, to regulate, restrict or prohibit the sale, acquisition, transfer, ownership, pos-13 session, storage, transportation or use of firearms or any element relating to firearms and 14 components thereof, including ammunition. Ordinances and policies that are contrary to this sub-15 section are void.

16 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 166.170 by section 1 of this 2017 Act apply to contracts entered into or renewed on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.
