Senate Bill 69

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Secretary of State to conduct evaluation on whether relevant sections in chapter 756, Oregon Laws 2013, improved transparency in campaign finance reporting and whether additional legislation is necessary.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to elections; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Secretary of State shall conduct an evaluation on:

5 (a) Whether the amendments to ORS 260.005, 260.039, 260.042, 260.044, 260.057, 260.083,

6 260.118 and 260.232 by sections 1 to 5 and 8 to 10, chapter 756, Oregon Laws 2013, and the

7 creation of ORS 260.095 by section 7, chapter 756, Oregon Laws 2013, have improved trans-

8 parency in campaign finance reporting; and

9 (b) Whether additional legislation is necessary to further improve transparency in cam 10 paign finance reporting.

11 (2) The secretary shall submit a report on the evaluation described in subsection (1) of 12 this section to the interim legislative committees on rules no later than September 15, 2015.

13 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 14 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 15 on its passage.

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
