SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure

Requires [Oregon Health Authority] Department of Consumer and Business Services to study cost differences in [pharmaceuticals] hormone replacement drugs used [primarily] by men and [pharmaceuticals] hormone replacement drugs used [primarily] by women and report findings to Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022. Sunsets January 2, 2023.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to gender disparities in cost of pharmaceuticals; and prescribing an effective date.

Whereas the cost of pharmaceuticals taken primarily by women is frequently more expensive 3

than the cost of pharmaceuticals taken primarily by men; now, therefore, 4

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: $\mathbf{5}$

SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Services, as part of the pre-6

scription drug transparency program described in ORS 646A.689, shall conduct a study of 7 disparities in the cost of hormone replacement drugs between those for men and those for 8 women. 9

(2) The department shall report the findings of its study to the Legislative Assembly, in 10

the manner provided in ORS 192.245, no later than September 15, 2022. The report shall in-11

12clude recommendations for legislative changes, if necessary, to address disparities in the 13 costs of hormone replacement drugs based on sex.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023. 14

SECTION 3. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021 15 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. 16
