(1) Prior to approving a tentative plan for a proposed plat of a proposed subdivision or partition that is subject to review under ORS 92.044, and that is located in 3 whole or in part within the boundaries, an easement or a right of way of an irrigation dis-4 $\mathbf{5}$ trict, drainage district, water control district or water improvement district, a city or a county shall submit notice of the tentative plan to the district. 6 7 "(2) Within 15 days of receiving notice under subsection (1) of this section, the district may submit to the city or the county a statement containing any information or recom-8 9 mended conditions for approval of the tentative plan for the proposed plat relating to: 10 "(a) The structural integrity of irrigation facilities; 11 "(b) District water supply; 12"(c) Public safety; 13 "(d) Potential liabilities of the district; or 14 "(e) Other potential exposures to the district. 15 "(3) The district shall base the information and recommended conditions of approval in-16 cluded in the statement described in subsection (2) of this section on rules and regulations 17 adopted by the district. 18 "(4) The city or the county may include the conditions for approval described in sub-19 section (2) of this section in the final decision approving the tentative plan of the proposed plat. 20 21"SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 198. "SECTION 4. (1) For the purposes of providing cities and counties with the necessary 22information to fulfill the requirements of section 2 of this 2017 Act, each irrigation district, 2324 drainage district, water control district and water improvement district shall submit a report 25detailing the locations of the district boundaries, district facilities and any easements and 26rights of way held by the district to each city and county in which any part of the district 27is located. 28"(2) A irrigation district, drainage district, water control district or water improvement 29district that submits a report to a city or a county under subsection (1) of this section shall give notice to the city or the county within 90 days of any change to the location of a district 30 31 boundary, district facility or any easement or right of way held by the district. 32"SECTION 5. Each irrigation district, drainage district, water control district and water improvement district shall submit the report required under section 4 (1) of this 2017 Act 33 34 on or before January 1, 2019.". 35

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
