

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 935

- 1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, delete “creating new provisions;”.
- 2 Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:
- 3 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 671.560 is amended to read:
- 4 **“671.560. (1)** Except as provided in ORS 671.571 and 671.590, the State Landscape Contractors
- 5 Board shall issue a landscape construction professional license to an applicant who satisfies the
- 6 requirements of ORS 671.570.
- 7 **“(2)** The board shall issue a landscape contracting business license to an applicant who satisfies
- 8 the requirements of the board.
- 9 **“(3)** An applicant for a license under this section shall apply to the board upon a form furnished
- 10 by the board and give such information as the board considers necessary.
- 11 **“(4)(a)** The board may issue a limited or specialty license if the applicant is required to have a
- 12 landscape construction professional license or landscape contracting business license but is not
- 13 qualified or required to be licensed for all phases of landscape work.
- 14 **“(b) The board may not issue to a person holding an endorsement as a residential or**
- 15 **commercial general contractor under ORS chapter 701 a limited or specialty license that:**
- 16 **“(A) Requires the holder of the limited or specialty landscape construction professional**
- 17 **license to be the owner of a licensed landscape contracting business;**
- 18 **“(B) Limits the permissible amount to be charged by the landscape contracting business**
- 19 **for landscape work to, within any 12-month period, an amount set by the board not to exceed**
- 20 **\$10,000 per customer; and**
- 21 **“(C) Has reduced qualification or testing requirements.**
- 22 **“[(b)] (c)** The board may adopt rules to limit or restrict the landscape work performed by
- 23 probationary landscape construction professionals.
- 24 **“(5)** A landscape contracting business that qualifies for the exemption described in ORS 571.045
- 25 shall indicate on its license application or license renewal application under this section the reasons
- 26 the business qualifies for the exemption.
- 27 **“SECTION 2. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019**
- 28 **regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
