SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Department of Human Services to research and report to Legislative Assembly on rights of individuals with intellectual disabilities.

Sunsets December 31, 2018.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to the rights of individuals with intellectual disabilities. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall research the rights of individuals with intellectual disabilities under state and federal laws. The department shall report its findings to the Legislative Assembly, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, no later than September 1, 2018. SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on December 31, 2018.
