1 Amend Bill, page 9, by inserting between lines 6 and 7

2 (6) The application shall include an affidavit to ensure  
3 that a contractor or subcontractor performing construction,  
4 reconstruction, demolition, repair or maintenance work on a  
5 project funded under this section meets all of the following  
6 requirements:

7 (i) Maintains all valid licenses, registrations or  
8 certificates required by the Federal Government, the  
9 Commonwealth or a local government entity that is  
10 necessary to do business or perform applicable work.

11 (ii) Maintains compliance with the act of June 2,  
12 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers'  
13 Compensation Act, the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd  
14 Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment  
15 Compensation Law, and bonding and liability insurance  
16 requirements as specified in the contract for the project  
17 under this section.

18 (iii) Has not defaulted on a project, declared  
19 bankruptcy, been debarred or suspended on a project by  
20 the Federal Government, the Commonwealth or a local  
21 government entity within the previous three years.

22 (iv) Has not been convicted of a misdemeanor or  
23 felony relating to the performance or operation of the  
24 business of the contractor or subcontractor within the  
25 previous 10 years.

26 (v) Has completed a minimum of the United States  
27 Occupational Safety and Health Administration's 10-hour  
28 safety training course or similar training sufficient to  
29 prepare workers for any hazards that may be encountered  
30 during their work.
