14 Section 17. To Whom Provisions in this Act Shall Not
15 Apply.--(a) Nothing in this act shall prohibit service in case
16 of emergency or domestic administration without compensation,
17 nor service by persons authorized under the laws of this State
18 to practice medicine, surgery, dentistry, chiropody, osteopathy,
19 or chiropractice, nor services by barbers lawfully engaged in
20 the performance of the usual and ordinary duties of their
21 vocation. Nothing in this act is intended to be inconsistent
22 with the act[, approved the nineteenth day of June, one thousand
23 nine hundred and thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws, five hundred eighty-
24 nine), entitled "An act to promote the public health and safety,
25 by providing for the examination and licensure of those who
26 desire to engage in the occupation of barbering; regulating
27 barber shops, barber schools and barber colleges, and
28 apprentices and students therein; conferring certain powers and
29 duties on the Department of Public Instruction; and providing
30 penalties."] of June 19, 1931 (P.L.589, No.202), referred to as

1 the Barbers' License Law.

2 (b) Nothing in this act shall prohibit or regulate the
3 practice of natural hair braiding by a person who desires to
4 engage in the practice of natural hair braiding or to operate a
5 business dedicated to the practice of natural hair braiding if
6 the person or business does not engage in any other practices or
7 activities that constitute the practice of cosmetology.
