

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1820

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 22, by inserting after "amended"

2 and the section is amended by adding a definition

3 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 6 and 7

4 "Threading" means removing hair from the eyebrows, upper lip
5 or other body part by using a cotton thread to pull hair from
6 follicles. The term includes the use of over-the-counter
7 astringents, gels, powders, tweezers or scissors incidental to
8 threading. The term is distinct from the practice of cosmetology
9 and esthetics.

13 Amend Bill, page 3, line 10, by inserting after

14 "Prohibited.--"

16 Amend Bill, page 3, line 14, by striking out all of said line

18 (1) To practice or teach cosmetology for compensation, or to
19 use or maintain any place for the practice of cosmetology for
20 compensation, or to use or maintain any place for the teaching
21 of cosmetology.

22 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 18 and 19

23 (b) An individual engaged solely in the practice of
24 threading is exempt from this act.

25 (c) A facility where an individual provides a service under
26 subsection (b) and no other service requiring a license under
27 this act is exempt from cosmetology and esthetics salon license
28 requirements.

29 (d) An individual who is exempt from this act under
30 subsection (b) shall be permitted to provide a service under

1 subsection (b) and no other service requiring a license under
2 this act in a licensed cosmetology salon or licensed esthetics
3 salon.
