1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 12 through 14, by striking out all
2 of said lines and inserting

3 Section 1. The definitions of "doctor of osteopathy or
4 osteopathic doctor" and "primary supervising physician" in
5 section 2 of the act of December 20, 1985 (P.L.457, No.112),
6 known as the Medical Practice Act of 1985, are amended to read:

9 "Doctor of osteopathy or osteopathic doctor." An individual
10 licensed to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery by the
11 State Board of Osteopathic [Medical Examiners.] Medicine under
12 the act of October 5, 1978 (P.L.1109, No.261), known as the
13 Osteopathic Medical Practice Act.

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15 "Primary supervising physician." A medical doctor who is
16 [registered with the board and] licensed by the board or a
17 doctor of osteopathy or osteopathic doctor who is licensed by
18 the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine and is designated in a
19 written agreement with a physician assistant under section 13(e)
20 as having primary responsibility for supervising the physician
21 assistant.

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
