SUMMARY:

House Bill 1013 amends the Public School Code concerning Keystone Exams and graduation requirements. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1013 requires that, no later than the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year, an industry-recognized credential attained by a student must be included on the student's transcript by a school district or other local education agency. An industry credential is defined as a credential identified in the industry credential resource book or in the industry-based learning guidelines compiled by the Department of Education.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
