SUMMARY:

House Bill 1393 amends a definition in the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1393 amends the definition of "drug paraphernalia" in the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act. It adds language specifically stating that the definition does not include testing products utilized in determining whether a controlled substance contains chemicals, toxic substances or hazardous compounds in quantities which can cause physical harm or death. The term "testing products" includes, but is not limited to, fentanyl test strips.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
