SUMMARY: House Bill 2586, Printer's Number 3100, amends Title 38 to designate March 29th of each year as "Tuskegee Airmen Commemoration Day" in Pennsylvania.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Title 38 (Holidays and Observations) to insert a new Section 1304 recognizing Tuskegee Airmen Commemoration Day. It designates March 29 of each year as Tuskegee Airmen Commemoration Day to highlight "the courage, dedication and service of the men and women of the Tuskegee Airmen continues to inspire both military personnel and civilians of all backgrounds throughout this country" as stated under this section.

The Governor shall issue annually a proclamation encouraging all public schools and educational institutions to observe Tuskegee Airmen Commemoration Day and to conduct exercises recognizing the contributions of the Tuskegee Airmen and remembering the sacrifices they made for their country. The proclamation may not mandate a public school or educational institution to participate in the observance.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
