**DESCRIPTION**

House Bill 2586 amends Title 38 (Holidays and Observances) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to include an additional veteran recognition day.

Title 38 is amended by adding a new § 1304 (relating to Tuskegee Airmen Commemoration Day) to recognize the contributions of the Tuskegee Airmen. This legislation designates March 29 of each year as "Tuskegee Airmen Commemoration Day."

Additionally, this legislation requires the Governor to issue annually a proclamation encouraging all public schools and educational institutions to observe Tuskegee Airmen Commemoration Day and to conduct exercises recognizing the contributions of the Tuskegee Airmen and remembering the sacrifices they made for their country. The proclamation may not mandate a public school or education institution to participate in the observance.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Enactment of this legislation will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
