10	(b) Consecutive sentencesThe court shall order that any
11	sentence imposed for a violation of subsection (a)[, or any
12	sentence imposed for a violation of section 2702(a) (relating to
13	aggravated assault) where the victim is a detention facility or
14	correctional facility employee, be served consecutively with the
15	person's current sentence.] <u>or any of the following offenses by</u>
16	a person who is confined in or committed to any local or county
17	detention facility, jail or prison or any State penal or
18	correctional institution or other State penal or correctional

1	facility located in this Commonwealth, including an attempt,
2	solicitation or conspiracy to commit any of the following
3	offenses, where the victim is a detention facility or
4	correctional facility employee be served consecutively with the
5	person's current sentence:
6	Section 2501 (relating to criminal homicide).
7	Section 2702 (relating to aggravated assault).
8	Section 2703.1 (relating to aggravated harassment by
9	prisoner).
10	Section 2704.
11	Section 2706 (relating to terroristic threats).
12	Section 2718 (relating to strangulation).
13	Section 3121 (relating to rape).
14	Section 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual
15	<u>intercourse).</u>
16	Section 3124.1 (relating to sexual assault).
17	Section 3125 (relating to aggravated indecent assault).
18	Section 3126 (relating to indecent assault).
19	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
