## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," prohibiting funding to an institution of higher education that engages in a boycott against or divestment from Israel.
8	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding an
12	article to read:

16	Section 2001-H. Findings.
17	The General Assembly finds as follows:
18	(1) Israel is America's dependable, democratic ally in

- the Middle East, an area of paramount strategic importance to
- 2 the United States.
- 3 (2) It is in the interest of the United States and the
- 4 <u>Commonwealth to stand with Israel by promoting trade and</u>
- 5 <u>commercial activities with Israel and its citizens and by</u>
- 6 <u>discouraging policies that contravene that interest.</u>
- 7 Section 2002-H. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this article
- 9 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Boycott against or divestment from Israel." Actions that
- 12 are politically motivated and are intended to penalize Israel or
- 13 otherwise limit commercial activities.
- "Commercial activities." Owning or controlling property or
- 15 <u>assets located in, having employees or facilities located in,</u>
- 16 providing goods or services to, having distribution agreements
- 17 with, issuing credit or loans to, purchasing bonds or commercial
- 18 paper issued by, investing in or having equity ties to or with
- 19 Israel or any company or person domiciled in Israel.
- 20 "Company." Any sole proprietorship, organization,
- 21 association, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited
- 22 partnership, limited liability partnership, limited liability
- 23 company or other entity or business association.
- "Institution of higher education." A postsecondary
- 25 <u>educational institution in this Commonwealth.</u>
- 26 "Israel." The State of Israel.
- 27 Section 2003-H. Prohibition.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Commonwealth
- 29 may not provide funding of any kind to an institution of higher
- 30 education that engages in a boycott against or divestment from

- 1 <u>Israel.</u>
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
