12	(d) PenaltyAny person violating any of the provisions of
13	subsection (a) or (b) commits a summary offense and shall, upon
14	conviction, be sentenced to either or both of the following:
15	(1) To pay a fine of not more than:
16	(i) [\$900] <u>\$1,100</u> for a violation which occurs in an
17	easement purchased under the program established by
18	section 14.1 of the act of June 30, 1981 (P.L.128,

At least 5% of the amount allocated by this 15 paragraph shall be used for signage to be placed along 16 17 Pennsylvania roadways that notifies the public of littering 18 fines. 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
