7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. Section 4968(a.2)(4) and (b) of Title 75 of the
9	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
10	§ 4968. Permit for movement during course of manufacture.

12	(a.2) Specifications

14	(4) A combination [of vehicles] which is hauling milk to
15	or from a [manufacturer] <u>milk plant or to or from a dairy</u>
16	farm, or is traveling to a dairy farm to pick up milk, may be
17	permitted by the department and local authorities to move

upon highways within their respective jurisdictions 24 hours a day, seven days a week, [except during inclement weather as defined in department regulations,] if [the] <u>all of the</u> following apply:

5 (i) The combination is identified as a licensed milk
6 hauler by a decal issued by the Pennsylvania Milk
7 Marketing Board, at a fee set by the Pennsylvania Milk
8 Marketing Board.

9 <u>(ii) The</u> gross weight does not exceed 95,000 pounds 10 and the weight of any nonsteering axle does not exceed 11 21,000 pounds. A permit may be issued for this type of 12 movement upon an interstate highway. An application to 13 the department for the movement of milk, except for raw 14 milk, shall designate the route the applicant requests to 15 use.

(b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection:

"Bulk milk." The term shall mean milk, as defined in section 1 of the act of July 2, 1935 (P.L.589, No.210), referred to as the Milk Sanitation Law, which is not transported in packages. "Condensed milk" and "evaporated milk." The term shall mean manufactured dairy products as defined in section 1 of the act of July 2, 1935 (P.L.589, No.210), referred to as the Milk Sanitation Law, which is not transported in packages.

Power of Governor during emergency. 20 (a) General rule.--[In] Except as provided under subsection (a.1) and section 4968(a.2)(4) (relating to permit for movement_ 21 during course of manufacture), in the event of a declared 22 23 National, State or local emergency when the Governor of this Commonwealth, under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301 (relating to general 24 25 <u>authority of Governor)</u>, has made a specific determination that modification of any of the provisions of this title will aid in 26 27 the alleviation of the stated emergency conditions, the Governor shall have the power to so modify the provisions on any or all 28 29 highways in this Commonwealth to be effective at any or all 30 hours of the day or night with respect to any or all types or 20230HB0102PN0010 - 3 -
