Section 2. Section 4(a) and (b) of the act are amended and 3 4 the section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 5 Section 4. State Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers. 6 (a) Creation. -- There is hereby created the State Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers as a departmental 7 8 administrative board in the Department of State. The board shall 9 consist of the following members: 10 (1)The Secretary of the Commonwealth or a designee. 11 The Attorney General or a designee. (2)The Secretary of Banking or a designee. 12 (3)

13 (4) [Eight] Ten members who are citizens of the United 14 States and who have been residents of this Commonwealth for a 15 two-year period immediately prior to appointment[, two of 16 whom shall be public members and six]<u>. Six</u> of [whom] <u>the</u> 17 members shall be [persons who are] State-certified real estate appraisers[.], two of the members shall be certified 18 19 Pennsylvania evaluators and two of the members shall be 20 public members. Nothing in this paragraph shall prohibit the 21 appointment of a professional member who is a certified Pennsylvania evaluator and also a State-certified real estate 2.2 appraiser, except that the appointment shall specify in which 23 capacity the member is being appointed. 24

(b) Term of office.--The professional and public members shall serve four-year terms, except as provided in subsection (c) <u>or (c.1)</u>, and shall be appointed by the Governor by and with the advice and consent of a majority of the members elected to the Senate.
