Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for 1 2 application for driver's license or learner's permit. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 1506(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by 7 adding subsections to read: 8 § 1506. Application for driver's license or learner's permit. * * * 10 11 [(b) Signature and certification. -- The application shall be 12 signed by the applicant who shall certify that the statements made are true and correct.1 13 (b.1) Compliance with Federal Selective Service Act. -- The 14 15 following shall apply: 16 (1) An individual between 18 and 26 years of age who applies for a driver's license or learner's permit and is 17

required to register with the Selective Service System in

1	compliance with the requirements of section 3 of the Military
2	Selective Service Act (62 Stat. 604, 50 U.S.C. § 3801 et
3	seq.) may consent to registration by the department by
4	checking the box provided on the application for such
5	purpose.
6	(2) The department shall place the check-off box
7	described under paragraph (1) and the following statement on
8	the application:
9	Failure to register with the Selective Service
10	System, if required by Federal law, is a felony
11	punishable by up to 5 years imprisonment or a
12	\$250,000 fine, or both. By checking the above box, I
13	am consenting to registration with the Selective
14	Service System. For applicants who object to
15	conventional military service for religious or other
16	conscientious reasons, alternative service
17	information is available from the Selective Service
18	System's publicly accessible Internet website.
19	(3) An application for a driver's license or learner's
20	permit may not be denied by the department if the applicant
21	declines to consent to registration with the Selective
22	Service System.
23	(4) The department shall forward, in electronic format
24	to the Selective Service System, the necessary personal
25	information of the consenting applicants required to comply
26	with the Military Selective Service Act.
27	(5) The department shall enter into an agreement with
28	the Selective Service System which provides for reimbursement
29	of the Motor License Fund by the Selective Service System for
30	the department's actual costs incurred in the development and

- 2 <u>the Selective Service System. The agreement shall address</u>
- 3 <u>other details relating to the development and implementation,</u>
- 4 <u>as necessary</u>, including the frequency of providing
- 5 <u>information to the Selective Service System.</u>
- 6 (c) Signature and certification. -- The application shall be
- 7 signed by the applicant who shall certify that the statements
- 8 made are true and correct.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in nine months.
