AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, further providing for home education program. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 9 Section 1. Section 1327.1 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 10 11 amended by adding subsections to read: 12 Section 1327.1. Home Education Program. --* * * 13 (f.2) (1) Beginning with the 2021 2022 2023-2024 school 14 year and each school year thereafter, the school district of 15 residence shall develop policies and procedures to permit a child who is enrolled in a home education program to 16 participate, on the same basis as other students enrolled in the 17

school district, in any cocurricular activity that merges extra-

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1 <u>curricular activities with a required academic class COURSE</u>,

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- 2 <u>including</u>, but not limited to, band or orchestra, and must
- 3 permit a child who is enrolled in a home education program to
- 4 <u>take up to four academic courses at a time PARTICIPATE IN</u>
- 5 ACADEMIC COURSES EQUALING UP TO AT LEAST ONE QUARTER OF THE
- 6 SCHOOL DAY FOR FULL-TIME STUDENTS, pursuant to the policies and
- 7 procedures of the school district of residence, on the same
- 8 basis as other students enrolled in the school district,
- 9 provided that the child:
- 10 (i) meets the eligibility criteria or their equivalent for
- 11 participation in the cocurricular or academic course that apply
- 12 to students enrolled full time in the school district;
- 13 (ii) meets the prerequisite criteria or their equivalent for
- 14 participation in the cocurricular or academic course that apply
- 15 to students enrolled full time in the school district; and
- 16 (iii) complies with all policies, rules and regulations or
- 17 their equivalent of the school district of residence.
- 18 (2) For the purposes of this subsection, the school district
- 19 of residence shall provide the grade for each cocurricular or
- 20 academic course to the home education program supervisor, who
- 21 shall be responsible for maintaining the material in the
- 22 portfolio of records.
- 23 (3) The parent/quardian PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN of the <--
- 24 child shall be responsible for transportation of the child to
- 25 and from school for the selected courses, except that a home
- 26 school EDUCATION student may utilize district transportation to <--
- 27 or from school during the times a bus is otherwise already
- 28 operating and space is available.
- 29 <u>(4) A board of school directors may adopt a policy to</u>
- 30 implement the requirements of this subsection. A POLICY UNDER

- 1 THIS PARAGRAPH MAY REQUIRE THAT THE COCURRICULAR OR ACADEMIC
- 2 COURSES TAKEN UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) BE TAKEN CONSECUTIVELY DURING
- 3 THE SCHOOL DAY IF THE SCHOOL OR A CHILD'S PARENT OR LEGAL
- 4 GUARDIAN IS NOT ABLE TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE SUPERVISION FOR THE
- 5 CHILD BETWEEN COCURRICULAR AND ACADEMIC COURSES. The policy
- 6 shall only apply to participation in cocurricular or academic
- 7 courses and shall not conflict with any provisions of this
- 8 section.
- 9 (5) A home education student enrolled in a cocurricular
- 10 activity or academic course in the student's school district of <--
- 11 <u>residence shall be included in the average daily membership of</u>
- 12 the school district of residence and shall be calculated by
- 13 counting the time the home education student spends in the
- 14 <u>public school program on a pro rata basis.</u>
- 15 (f.3) (1) Beginning with the 2021-2022 2023-2024 school <--

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- 16 year and each school year thereafter, the school district of
- 17 residence shall develop policies and procedures consistent with
- 18 the enrollment or seat allocation provisions of the written
- 19 agreement among the participating school districts which
- 20 established the career and technical education center, or in the
- 21 case of a school district operated career and technical
- 22 education program, the school district of residence shall
- 23 develop policies and procedures consistent with subsection
- 24 (f.2), to permit a home schooled EDUCATION student to
- 25 participate in a career and technical education program on the
- 26 same basis as other students enrolled in the school district,
- 27 provided that the child:
- 28 (i) meets the eligibility criteria or their equivalent for
- 29 participation in the career and technical education program that
- 30 apply to students enrolled full time in the school district;

- 1 (ii) meets the prerequisite criteria or their equivalent for
- 2 participation in the career and technical education program that
- 3 apply to students enrolled full time in the school district; and
- 4 (iii) complies with all policies, rules and regulations or
- 5 their equivalent of the school district of residence and the
- 6 career and technical education center.
- 7 (2) For the purposes of this subsection, the school district
- 8 of residence operated career and technical education program or
- 9 the career and technical education center shall provide the
- 10 grades to the home education program supervisor, who shall be
- 11 responsible for maintaining the material in the portfolio of
- 12 <u>records.</u>
- 13 (3) The home school EDUCATION students may utilize district <--
- 14 transportation to or from the career and technical education
- 15 program during the times buses are otherwise already operating
- 16 <u>and space is available.</u>
- 17 (4) A board of school directors may adopt a policy to
- 18 implement the requirements of this subsection. Such policy shall
- 19 only apply to participation in career and technical education
- 20 programs and shall not conflict with any provisions of this
- 21 section.
- 22 (5) A home education student enrolled in the career and
- 23 technical education program shall be included in the average
- 24 daily membership of the school district of residence and career
- 25 and technical center, if applicable, and shall be calculated by
- 26 counting the time the home education student spends in the
- 27 career and technical education program on a pro rata basis.
- 28 (F.4) NOTHING IN SUBSECTIONS (F.2) AND (F.3) SHALL PROHIBIT <--
- 29 A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR A CAREER AND TECHNICAL CENTER FROM
- 30 ESTABLISHING POLICIES THAT PRIORITIZE PARTICIPATION IN COURSES

- 1 OR PROGRAMS WITH LIMITED SEATING OR ENROLLMENT.
