## AN ACT

11	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12	hereby enacts as follows:
13	Section 1. The act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.216, No.76), known as
14	The Dental Law, is amended by adding a section to read:
15	Section 4.2. Temporary Volunteer Dental Licenses(a) The
16	board shall issue a temporary volunteer license to an individual
17	who meets all of the following requirements:
18	(1) Holds an active license to practice dentistry in this
19	<u>Commonwealth or in another state or territory.</u>
20	(2) Documents to the satisfaction of the board that the
21	applicant will practice dentistry in this Commonwealth without

- 1 personal remuneration.
- 2 (3) Is current on all continuing education requirements.
- 3 <u>(4) Demonstrates medical professional liability insurance</u>
- 4 coverage as required under section 3.2.
- 5 (5) Is not the subject of an ongoing disciplinary
- 6 <u>investigation</u>.
- 7 (b) By request of the applicant, the board may issue:
- 8 (1) one thirty-day temporary volunteer license per applicant
- 9 <u>per year; or</u>
- 10 (2) up to three ten-day temporary volunteer licenses per
- 11 <u>applicant per year.</u>
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
