- Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further 2 providing for definitions. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The definition of "sexual abuse or exploitation" 6 in section 6303(a) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 7 Statutes is amended to read: 8 \$ 6303. Definitions. 10 General rule. -- The following words and phrases when used 11 in this chapter shall have the meanings given to them in this 12 section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: * * * 13 14 "Sexual abuse or exploitation." Any of the following:
- 15 The employment, use, persuasion, inducement,
- 16 enticement or coercion of a child to engage in or assist
- 17 another individual to engage in sexually explicit conduct,
- 18 which includes, but is not limited to, the following:

1 Looking at the sexual or other intimate parts of 2 a child or another individual for the purpose of arousing 3 or gratifying sexual desire in any individual. Participating in sexually explicit conversation 4 5 either in person, by telephone, by computer or by a computer-aided device for the purpose of sexual 6 7 stimulation or gratification of any individual. 8 (iii) Actual or simulated sexual activity or nudity for the purpose of sexual stimulation or gratification of 9 any individual. 10 11 (iv) Actual or simulated sexual activity for the 12 purpose of producing visual depiction, including 13 photographing, videotaping, computer depicting or 14 filming.
