## AN ACT

Amending the act of August 14, 1963 (P.L.1059, No.459), entitled "An act prohibiting future need sales of cemetery merchandise 2 and services, funeral merchandise and services, except under 3 certain conditions; requiring the establishment of and deposit into a merchandise trust fund of certain amount of the proceeds of any such sale; providing for the 6 administration of such trust funds and the payment of money 7 therefrom; conferring powers and imposing duties on orphans' 8 courts, and prescribing penalties," further providing for 9 10 merchandise trust fund. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 1.3 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of August 14, 1963 14 (P.L.1059, No.459), referred to as the Cemetery and Funeral 15 Merchandise Trust Fund Law, is amended by adding a subsection to 16 read: 17 Section 2. \* \* \* 18 (a.1) A seller shall provide price lists and detailed 19 descriptions of all merchandise offered by a seller to a person 20 who inquires about the merchandise. (1) A seller shall provide the price lists and descriptions 21

required under this subsection to a person, in writing, upon

- 1 beginning discussion of, but prior to, the showing of the
- 2 merchandise. Information that must be provided shall include:
- 3 (i) The retail price of all merchandise, including caskets,
- 4 <u>alternative containers and outer burial containers, such as lawn</u>
- 5 crypts, that are offered by a seller and do not require special
- 6 <u>ordering</u>.
- 7 (ii) Descriptive information sufficient to identify and
- 8 compare individual items.
- 9 (iii) All fees imposed by a seller including processing
- 10 fees, delivery fees, installation fees, inspection fees or road
- 11 maintenance fees or any other fee that may be charged when a
- 12 <u>person purchases merchandise from a seller.</u>
- 13 <u>(iv) The effective date for the price list.</u>
- 14 <u>(v) The name and address of the seller.</u>
- 15 (vi) A heading describing the type of merchandise contained
- 16 on the list.
- 17 (2) A seller may satisfy the requirements of this subsection
- 18 with a single list if all of the required information is
- 19 contained on the list.
- 20 (3) Notebooks, brochures, charts or other formats may be
- 21 used to satisfy the requirements of this subsection.
- 22 Notwithstanding the format, the information required under this
- 23 subsection must be displayed in a clear and conspicuous manner.

- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
