## AN ACT

6	Section 1. Chapter 57 of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:

12	<u>§ 5751. Notification requirements.</u>
13	(a) General ruleNotwithstanding any other provision of
14	law, during the COVID-19 disaster emergency, a business
15	operating in this Commonwealth which provides consumer goods and
16	services shall notify consumers if the price of a consumer good
17	or service has increased by 10% or more since the issuance of
18	the COVID-19 disaster emergency.

1	(b) RequirementsNotification shall occur at the point of
2	sale and be presented in a conspicuous and prominent place. The
3	notification shall include the price of the good or service
4	prior to the issuance of the COVID-19 disaster emergency, the
5	current price of the good or service and the percentage of
6	increase during that time.
7	(c) Online purchasesFor online purchases, a consumer
8	shall be notified of the price increase as provided under
9	subsection (b) prior to the completion of the sale transaction.
10	(d) JustificationA business may provide justification for
11	the price increase when the price increase is beyond the control
12	<u>of the business.</u>
13	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
