AN ACT

1 Making appropriations from the General Fund to the Government
2 Support Agencies for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019,
3 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at
4 the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

8 PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

9 Section 101. Short title.

10 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Appropriation
11 Act of 2019 - Government Support Agencies.

17 Section 301. Appropriations from General Fund.

18 The following amounts, or as much thereof as may be
19 necessary, are hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the

1 Government Support Agencies for the purposes specified in this
2 part for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, and for the
3 payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of
4 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020.

22 Caucus Computer Services Account,
23 and an allocation of \$5,355,000 to
24 the House of Representatives
25 Democratic Caucus Computer Services
26 Account for the payment of
27 operating costs, contracts,
28 equipment, software, other
29 incidental expenses and costs to be
30 disbursed at the direction of the

1 Speaker of the House of
2 Representatives and the Minority
3 Leader of the House of
