AN ACT

1 Designating that portion of Pennsylvania Route 92 from Apple
2 Tree Road to Rustic Lane in Exeter Township, Luzerne County,
3 as the Robert F. Kile, Sr., Memorial Highway.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Robert F. Kile, Sr., Memorial Highway.

7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
8 follows:

9 (1) Robert "Bob" F. Kile, Sr., was born February 9,
10 1963, in Wilkes-Barre.

11 (2) Mr. Kile attended Bishop O'Reilly High School and,
12 upon graduation, received certificates from Luzerne Carbon
13 Community College and Bucks County Community College.

14 (3) Mr. Kile served his country with honor and
15 distinction as a member of the United States Army and the
16 Pennsylvania National Guard.

17 (4) Throughout Mr. Kile's life, he held many different
18 roles in the community and professionally, including Chair of

1 the Exeter Township Board of Supervisors, Chief of the
2 Franklin Township Fire Department, Ambulance Chief of Dallas
3 Fire and Ambulance, Second Assistant Chief and Vice President
4 of the Mt. Zion Bicentennial Fire Company, Second Assistant
5 Commander of the Harding/Mt. Zion Ambulance Association, and
6 was a certified emergency medical technician and a 10-year
7 employee with the Department of Transportation.

8 (5) Robert "Bob" F. Kile, Sr., died June 19, 2020, at
9 his home.

10 (b) Designation.--That portion of Pennsylvania Route 92 from
11 Apple Tree Road to Rustic Lane in Exeter Township, Luzerne
12 County, is designated the Robert F. Kile, Sr., Memorial Highway.

13 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
14 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
15 traffic in both directions on the highway.

16 Section 2. Effective date.

17 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
