- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, providing for digitized 1 2 driver's licenses. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Chapter 15 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read: 8 SUBCHAPTER E 9 DIGITIZED DRIVER'S LICENSES

- 2 § 1591. Scope of subchapter.
- 3 This subchapter relates to digitized driver's licenses, which
- 4 may be used in addition to the driver's licenses required under
- 5 this chapter.
- 6 § 1592. Purpose.
- 7 The purpose of this subchapter is to provide an individual
- 8 with a driver's license issued by the Commonwealth the option of
- 9 downloading a digitized version of the driver's license of the
- 10 individual through a mobile application that the department
- 11 would offer.
- 12 § 1593. Definitions.
- 13 The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 14 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 15 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 16 "Digitized driver's license." A data file available on a
- 17 mobile device that has connectivity to the Internet through an
- 18 application that:
- 19 (1) allows the mobile device to download the data file
- from the department or an authorized representative of the
- 21 department;
- 22 (2) contains all the data elements visible on the face
- 23 and back of the driver's license of an individual; and
- 24 (3) displays the current status of the driver's license
- of an individual, including, but not limited to, valid,
- 26 expired, canceled, suspended, revoked, disqualified, hardship
- 27 <u>or interlock hardship status.</u>
- 28 § 1594. Mobile application.
- 29 <u>The department shall offer to each individual with a driver's</u>
- 30 license issued by the Commonwealth a mobile application capable

- 1 of downloading a digitized driver's license for the individual.
- 2 § 1595. Validity of digitized driver's license.
- 3 (a) General rule. -- Except as otherwise provided in
- 4 <u>subsection</u> (b), a digitized driver's license shall serve the
- 5 same purpose and have the same effect as any other driver's
- 6 <u>license under this chapter.</u>
- 7 (b) Exception. -- A digitized driver's license shall not
- 8 <u>negate the obligation to have and carry a physical version of a</u>
- 9 <u>driver's license as specified under the other provisions of this</u>
- 10 chapter. A digitized driver's license shall supplement and not
- 11 replace a physical version of a driver's license required under
- 12 the other provisions of this chapter.
- 13 § 1596. Effect of other electronic images.
- 14 A digital copy, photograph or any other image of a driver's
- 15 license that is not downloaded as a digitized driver's license
- 16 <u>shall not be valid for purposes of this chapter.</u>
- 17 § 1597. Effect on law enforcement.
- 18 (a) Citation. -- If an individual is unable to produce a
- 19 physical version of the driver's license of the individual in
- 20 connection with a traffic stop or checkpoint, the individual may
- 21 present the individual's digitized driver's license to a law
- 22 enforcement officer. In such an instance, the law enforcement
- 23 <u>officer may not issue a citation to the individual for driving a</u>
- 24 motor vehicle without having the physical version of the
- 25 driver's license.
- 26 (b) Unlawful search. -- The following shall apply in the
- 27 <u>absence of a valid search warrant regarding an individual's</u>
- 28 mobile device:
- 29 (1) The display of an individual's digitized driver's
- 30 license shall not be construed as consent or authorization by

- 1 the individual for a law enforcement officer or any other
- 2 person to search, view or access any other data or
- 3 application on the individual's mobile device.
- 4 (2) If an individual presents a mobile device to a law
- 5 <u>enforcement officer or other person for the purpose of</u>
- displaying the individual's digitized driver's license, the
- 7 law enforcement officer or other person shall promptly return
- 8 the mobile device to the individual immediately after the law
- 9 enforcement officer or other person has had the opportunity
- 10 to verify the identity or driver's license status of the
- 11 <u>individual.</u>
- 12 <u>§ 1598.</u> Fees.
- 13 <u>The department shall prescribe a schedule of reasonable fees</u>
- 14 for an individual to use the mobile application established
- 15 <u>under this subchapter. The fees shall be designed to keep the</u>
- 16 mobile application accessible and functioning and may include:
- 17 (1) A reasonable download fee.
- 18 (2) A reasonable fee when the driver's license of the
- individual is renewed or when the information on the driver's
- 20 license of the individual is updated.
- 21 § 1599. Rules and regulations.
- The department shall promulgate rules and regulations
- 23 necessary to implement the provisions of this subchapter.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
