AN ACT

1 Making appropriations from the General Fund to the Department of
2 Community and Economic Development for the fiscal year
3 beginning July 1, 2019, and for the payment of bills incurred
4 and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending
5 June 30, 2020.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 101. Short title.

11 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Appropriation
12 Act of 2019 - Department of Community and Economic Development.
