AN ACT

Amending the act of August 14, 1963 (P.L.1059, No.459), entitled "An act prohibiting future need sales of cemetery merchandise 2 and services, funeral merchandise and services, except under 3 certain conditions; requiring the establishment of and deposit into a merchandise trust fund of certain amount of the proceeds of any such sale; providing for the 6 administration of such trust funds and the payment of money 7 therefrom; conferring powers and imposing duties on orphans' 8 courts, and prescribing penalties," further providing for 9 merchandise trust fund; and prohibiting constructive or 10 preneed delivery of burial vaults. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of August 14, 1963 15 (P.L.1059, No.459), referred to as the Cemetery and Funeral Merchandise Trust Fund Law, is amended by adding a subsection to 16 17 read: Section 2. * * * 18 19 (a.1) A seller shall provide price lists and detailed 20 descriptions of all merchandise offered by a seller to a person 21 who inquires about the merchandise.

(1) A seller shall provide the price lists and descriptions

- 1 required under this subsection to a person, in writing, upon
- 2 beginning discussion of, but prior to, the showing of the
- 3 merchandise. Information that must be provided shall include:
- 4 (i) The retail price of all merchandise, including caskets,
- 5 alternative containers and outer burial containers, such as lawn
- 6 crypts, that are offered by a seller and do not require special
- 7 <u>ordering.</u>
- 8 (ii) Descriptive information sufficient to identify and
- 9 <u>compare individual items.</u>
- 10 (iii) All fees imposed by a seller including processing
- 11 fees, delivery fees, installation fees, inspection fees or road
- 12 <u>maintenance fees or any other fee that may be charged when a</u>
- 13 person purchases merchandise from a seller.
- 14 <u>(iv) The effective date for the price list.</u>
- 15 (v) The name and address of the seller.
- 16 (vi) A heading describing the type of merchandise contained
- 17 on the list.
- 18 (2) A seller may satisfy the requirements of this subsection
- 19 with a single list if all of the required information is
- 20 contained on the list.
- 21 (3) Notebooks, brochures, charts or other formats may be
- 22 <u>used to satisfy the requirements of this subsection.</u>
- 23 Notwithstanding the format, the information required under this
- 24 subsection must be displayed in a clear and conspicuous manner.

- 26 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 27 <u>Section 3.1. Constructive or preneed delivery of burial</u>
- 28 <u>vaults is prohibited. This prohibition shall not apply to lawn</u>
- 29 crypts.
- 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
