AN ACT

1 Making appropriations from the restricted revenue accounts  
2 within the State Gaming Fund and from the State Gaming Fund  
3 to the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board, the Department of  
4 Revenue, the Pennsylvania State Police and the Attorney  
5 General for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, to June  
6 30, 2016, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining  
7 unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 PART I

11 PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

12 Section 101. Short title.--This act shall be known and may  
13 be cited as the Gaming Control Appropriation Act of 2015.

14 PART III

15 STATE GAMING CONTROL

16 RESTRICTED REVENUE ACCOUNTS

17 Section 301. State Gaming Fund.--The following amounts set  
18 forth in this part, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are  
19 hereby appropriated from the State Gaming Fund restricted  
20 revenue accounts under 4 Pa.C.S. § 1401 (relating to slot  
21 machine licensee deposits) to the agencies of the Executive

1 Department named in this part for the purposes set forth for the  
2 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, and for the payment of bills  
3 incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year  
4 ending June 30, 2015.

5 Section 302. Attorney General.--The following  
6 amounts are appropriated to the Attorney General:

7 For salaries, wages and all necessary expenses  
8 of the Attorney General related to 4 Pa.C.S. Pt.  
9 II (relating to gaming).

10 State appropriation..... 1,192,000

11 Section 303. Department of Revenue.--The  
12 following amounts are appropriated to the  
13 Department of Revenue:

14 For the salaries, wages and all necessary  
15 expenses of the Department of Revenue related to 4  
16 Pa.C.S. Pt. II (relating to gaming).

17 State appropriation..... 9,513,000

18 Section 304. Pennsylvania State Police.--The  
19 following amounts are appropriated to the  
20 Pennsylvania State Police:

21 For the salaries, wages and all necessary  
22 expenses of the Pennsylvania State Police related  
23 to 4 Pa.C.S. Pt. II (relating to gaming).

24 State appropriation..... 26,973,000

25 Section 305. Pennsylvania Gaming Control  
26 Board.--The following amounts are appropriated to  
27 the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board:

28 For the salaries, wages and all necessary  
29 expenses for the proper operation and  
30 administration of the Pennsylvania Gaming Control

1 Board. This appropriation includes \$7,000,000 from  
2 the restricted revenue account established in the  
3 State Gaming Fund for fees and other revenues  
4 collected by the board.

5 State appropriation..... 39,900,000

6 PART V

7 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

8 Section 501. Transfers prohibited.--There is no authority  
9 for the State Treasurer, the Secretary of the Budget, the  
10 Secretary of Revenue or the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board to  
11 transfer any money within or between the appropriations in Part  
12 III.

13 Section 502. Effective date.--This act shall take effect  
14 July 1, 2015, or immediately, whichever is later.
