AN ACT

1 2	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for Gold Star Family plate.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Section 1365(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
6	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
7	§ 1365. Gold Star Family plate.
8	(a) General ruleUpon application of a family member of a
9	person who was killed while serving on active duty in the
10	military, accompanied by a fee of [\$20] $\frac{$7.50}{100}$ which shall be in
11	addition to the annual registration fee and by such
12	documentation as the department shall require, the department
13	shall issue to the family member a special registration plate
14	designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a family
15	member of a person who was killed while serving on active duty

1 in the military. The department shall design and produce the special registration plate carrying the Service Flag Gold Star 2 rimmed with blue which represents sacrifice to the cause of 3 liberty and freedom. The words "Gold Star Family" shall be 4 clearly displayed along the bottom of the plate. The special 5 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck 6 with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 7 8 pounds.
