Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania
    Consolidated Statutes, in local organizations and services,
    further providing for general authority of political
    subdivisions.
    The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
    Section 1. Section 7501(d) of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes, is amended to read:
$ 7501. General authority of political subdivisions.
    * *
(d) Temporary suspension of formal requirements.--Each political subdivision included in a declaration of disaster emergency declared by either the Governor or the governing body of the political subdivision affected by the disaster emergency is authorized to exercise the powers vested under this section in the light of the exigencies of the emergency situation without regard to time-consuming procedures and formalities prescribed by law (excepting mandatory constitutional

requirements) pertaining to the performance of public work,
entering into contracts, the incurring of obligations, the
employment of temporary workers, the rental of equipment, the
purchase of supplies and materials, the levying of taxes and the
appropriation and expenditure of public funds. Notwithstanding
any other provision of law, the governing body, board or
commission of a political subdivision shall not be required to
have a quorum physically present at any one location in order to
conduct business if a quorum is otherwise established by the
participating members through an authorized telecommunication
device.

    Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
