Amending the act of February 11, 1998 (P.L.58, No.15), entitled 1 "An act providing for the regulation of combustible and 2 flammable liquids; allocating functions of the Department of 3 Labor and Industry and the Pennsylvania State Police; imposing penalties; and making repeals," further providing 5 for regulations. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 4(c.1)(1) introductory paragraph of the 10 act of February 11, 1998 (P.L.58, No.15), known as the Combustible and Flammable Liquids Act, is amended to read: 11 12 Section 4. Regulations. 13 Emergency controls and electrical disconnects. --14 15 Fuel-dispensing systems shall be provided with one 16 or more clearly identified emergency shut-off devices or 17 electrical disconnects. Such devices or disconnects shall be 18 installed in approved locations not less than 20 feet nor more than 100 feet from the fuel-dispensing devices that they 19

- 1 serve. The farthest fuel-dispensing device shall be no more
- than [200] 350 feet from the master control emergency shut-
- 3 off device. Emergency shut-off devices or electrical
- 4 disconnects shall disconnect power to:

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
