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AN ACT

1 Amending the act of February 11, 1998 (P.L.58, No.15), entitled  
2 "An act providing for the regulation of combustibile and  
3 flammable liquids; allocating functions of the Department of  
4 Labor and Industry and the Pennsylvania State Police;  
5 imposing penalties; and making repeals," further providing  
6 for regulations.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 4(c.1)(1) introductory paragraph of the  
10 act of February 11, 1998 (P.L.58, No.15), known as the  
11 Combustible and Flammable Liquids Act, is amended to read:

12 Section 4. Regulations.

13 \* \* \*

14 (c.1) Emergency controls and electrical disconnects.--

15 (1) Fuel-dispensing systems shall be provided with one  
16 or more clearly identified emergency shut-off devices or  
17 electrical disconnects. Such devices or disconnects shall be  
18 installed in approved locations not less than 20 feet nor  
19 more than 100 feet from the fuel-dispensing devices that they

1       serve. The farthest fuel-dispensing device shall be no more  
2       than [200] 350 feet from the master control emergency shut-  
3       off device. Emergency shut-off devices or electrical  
4       disconnects shall disconnect power to:

6       Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
