- 1 § 6101. Definitions.
- 2 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 3 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 4 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 5 <u>"Cultural competence."</u> The ability to understand,
- 6 communicate with and effectively interact with people of
- 7 <u>different races</u>, ethnicities and cultures relating to health and
- 8 the delivery of health care.
- 9 "Department." The Department of State of the Commonwealth.
- 10 "Health-related State board." As follows:
- 11 <u>(1) Any of the following:</u>
- 12 <u>(i) The State Board of Chiropractic.</u>
- 13 <u>(ii) The State Board of Dentistry.</u>
- 14 (iii) The State Board of Massage Therapy.
- 15 (iv) The State Board of Medicine.
- 16 (v) The State Board of Nursing.
- 17 (vi) The State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home
- 18 Administrators.
- 19 (vii) The State Board of Occupational Therapy,
- 20 Education and Licensure.
- 21 <u>(viii) The State Board of Optometry.</u>
- 22 (ix) The State Board of Osteopathic Medicine.
- 23 <u>(x) The State Board of Pharmacy.</u>
- 24 (xi) The State Board of Physical Therapy.
- 25 (xii) The State Board of Podiatry.
- 26 (xiii) The State Board of Psychology.
- 27 (xiv) The State Board of Examiners in Speech-
- 28 Language Pathology and Audiology.
- 29 (xv) The State Board of Social Workers, Marriage and
- 30 Family Therapists and Professional Counselors.

- 1 (2) The term does not include the State Board of
- 2 <u>Veterinary Medicine.</u>
- 3 "Implicit bias." A belief or set of associations about a
- 4 group or an individual based upon physical characteristics,
- 5 race, ethnicity, gender, age, religious creed or sexual
- 6 orientation, which can result in the inaccurate attribution of
- 7 particular qualities to the group or individual.
- 8 § 6102. Continuing education.
- 9 <u>(a) Requirement.--The department shall require each person</u>
- 10 applying for a license or certification issued by a health-
- 11 related State board to complete training regarding implicit bias
- 12 and cultural competence in accordance with the continuing
- 13 <u>education requirements of the health-related State board. At a</u>
- 14 minimum, the training must include the understanding of implicit
- 15 bias, including, but not limited to, practical techniques to
- 16 <u>mitigate implicit bias and improve cultural competence.</u>
- 17 (b) Documentation.--Each person applying for a license or
- 18 certification issued by a health-related State board shall
- 19 <u>submit documentation acceptable to the health-related State</u>
- 20 board of the completion of the training under subsection (a).
- 21 § 6103. Regulations.
- 22 The department shall promulgate regulations regarding the
- 23 following:
- 24 (1) The competencies that must be achieved through the
- 25 curriculum and delivery of the training specified under
- 26 section 6102(a) (relating to continuing education).
- 27 (2) The minimum number of credit hours necessary for the
- training specified under section 6102(a).
- 29 Section 2. This act shall apply to a license or
- 30 certification issued by a health-related State board on or after

- 1 the date of the promulgation of the regulations under 63 Pa.C.S.
- 2 § 6103.
- 3 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
