AN ACT

Amending the act of June 19, 1931 (P.L.589, No.202), entitled "An act to promote the public health and safety, by providing 2 for the examination and licensure of those who desire to 3 engage in the profession of barbering; regulating barber shops and barber schools, and students therein; regulating 5 compensation for service rendered; conferring certain powers and duties on the Department of State; and providing penalties," further providing for barber's license-8 application SUPERVISION OF SHOPS AND SCHOOLS AND LICENSES AND <--9 RENEWAL. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 3(a) of the act of June 19, 1931 <--14 (P.L.589, No.202), referred to as the Barbers' License Law, is 15 amended to read: 16 Section 3. (a) Each applicant for a barber's license shall, as a condition precedent to obtaining a license, take the barber's license examination and score a passing grade. Prior to-18 19 taking the examination the applicant shall be at least sixteen 20 years of age, have completed the eighth grade or its equivalent

- 1 and have completed a barbering study and training period of at-
- 2 least one thousand two hundred fifty (1250) hours and not less-
- 3 than nine months either in a licensed barber school under the
- 4 instruction of a licensed teacher, or in a licensed barber shop-
- 5 under the instruction of a licensed teacher. A licensed barber
- 6 school may offer up to fifty per centum of the school's
- 7 curriculum through distance education. A student at a licensed
- 8 barber school may only earn barbering study and training hours
- 9 through distance education for theory based subjects. A licensed
- 10 barber school's curriculum may not offer practical
- 11 <u>demonstrations through distance education. For the purpose of</u>
- 12 this subsection, distance education shall include curriculum
- 13 offered by licensed barber school to a student while the student
- 14 is at a location separate and apart from the school. A notarized
- 15 application for a license as a barber shall be made in such form
- 16 as the board shall prescribe. The application shall also be
- 17 accompanied by a notarized statement, from either the licensed
- 18 barber school the applicant attended or the licensed barber
- 19 teacher in the licensed barber shop in which the applicant-
- 20 studied and trained, that the student has completed the study
- 21 and training period required in this subsection. At the time of
- 22 filing the application and accompanying notarized statements,
- 23 the applicant shall pay to the department an examination fee to-
- 24 be determined by regulation and shall present himself or herself-
- 25 at the next examination of applicants as provided in section 6.
- 26 The board shall not have the power to require a photograph as
- 27 part of an application for a barber's license.

- SECTION 1. SECTION 12(B) OF THE ACT OF JUNE 19, 1931
- 30 (P.L.589, NO.202), REFERRED TO AS THE BARBERS' LICENSE LAW, IS

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- 1 AMENDED TO READ:
- 2 SECTION 12. * * *
- 3 (B) NO SCHOOL OF BARBERING SHALL BE GRANTED A LICENSE OR
- 4 RENEWAL UNLESS IT REQUIRES AS A PREREQUISITE TO ADMISSION
- 5 THERETO, GRADUATION FROM THE EIGHTH GRADE IN A SECONDARY SCHOOL
- 6 OR ITS EQUIVALENT, AND IT SHALL ATTACH TO ITS STAFF, AS A PART-
- 7 TIME TEACHER, A PERSON LICENSED BY THE COMMONWEALTH TO PRACTICE
- 8 MEDICINE, AND EMPLOY AND MAINTAIN A SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF
- 9 LICENSED TEACHERS AND SHALL POSSESS APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT
- 10 SUFFICIENT FOR THE PROPER AND FULL TEACHING OF ALL SUBJECTS OF
- 11 ITS CURRICULUM; SHALL KEEP A DAILY RECORD OF THE ATTENDANCE OF
- 12 EACH STUDENT; SHALL MAINTAIN REGULAR CLASS AND INSTRUCTION
- 13 HOURS; SHALL ESTABLISH GRADES AND HOLD EXAMINATION BEFORE
- 14 ISSUANCE OF DIPLOMAS; AND SHALL BE REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN A COURSE
- 15 OF STUDY REQUIRING NOT LESS THAN ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY
- 16 HOURS FOR COMPLETION IN NOT LESS THAN NINE MONTHS; AND SHALL
- 17 COMPRISE ALL OF THE SUBJECTS PERTAINING TO BARBERING, THE BARBER
- 18 LAWS OF THIS STATE, AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE
- 19 BOARD; AND SHALL INCLUDE PRACTICAL DEMONSTRATIONS AND
- 20 THEORETICAL STUDIES AND STUDIES IN SANITATION, STERILIZATION AND
- 21 THE USE OF ANTISEPTICS, COSMETICS, AND ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES,
- 22 CONSISTENT WITH THE PRACTICAL AND THEORETICAL REQUIREMENTS AS
- 23 APPLICABLE TO BARBERING OR ANY PRACTICE THEREOF. A SCHOOL OF
- 24 BARBERING MAY OFFER UP TO FIFTY PER CENTUM OF THE SCHOOL'S
- 25 CURRICULUM THROUGH DISTANCE EDUCATION. A STUDENT AT A SCHOOL OF
- 26 BARBERING MAY ONLY EARN BARBERING STUDY AND TRAINING HOURS
- 27 THROUGH DISTANCE EDUCATION FOR THEORY-BASED SUBJECTS. THE
- 28 CURRICULUM OF A SCHOOL OF BARBERING MAY NOT OFFER PRACTICAL
- 29 <u>DEMONSTRATIONS THROUGH DISTANCE EDUCATION. FOR THE PURPOSE OF</u>
- 30 THIS SUBSECTION, DISTANCE EDUCATION SHALL INCLUDE CURRICULUM

- 1 OFFERED BY A SCHOOL OF BARBERING TO A STUDENT WHILE THE STUDENT
- 2 <u>IS AT A LOCATION SEPARATE AND APART FROM THE SCHOOL.</u>

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
