Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in powers of department and local authorities, 2 providing for period for application review. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 6119.1. Period for application review. 8 9 (a) Application processing, recordkeeping and refund 10 requirements. --11 (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3), the department shall process an application submitted by a person to the 12 13 department within 90 days of receipt of the application by 14 the department. 15 (2) Except as provided for in paragraph (3), if the 16 department approves a completed application from an applicant after the 90-day time period, the department shall refund any 17

fee required to be accompanied by the application.

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_	(3) If the department defines an application because the
2	application is incomplete and requires additional information
3	or documentation, the department shall provide a written
4	notice to the applicant requesting additional information or
5	documentation from the applicant. The department shall,
6	within 30 days of receipt of the additional information or
7	documentation from the applicant, process the application
8	with the additional information or documentation. If the
9	application is approved after the 30-day time period, the
10	department shall refund any fee required to be accompanied by
11	the application.
12	(4) The department shall maintain a record for an
13	application received by the department containing the
14	following information for no less than one year from the date
15	the department approves or denies the application:
16	(i) The date of receipt of the application.
17	(ii) The date of approval or denial of the
18	application.
19	(iii) If the application is denied, the reason for
20	the application denial.
21	(iv) If the application is denied because it is
22	incomplete and requires additional information or
23	documentation, the date the department sent the written
24	notice requesting the additional information or
25	documentation.
26	(v) If the applicant provides additional information
27	or documentation to the department after receiving a
28	written notice, the date of receipt of the additional
29	information or documentation by the department and the
30	date of approval or denial of an application and reason

- 2 (5) An applicant may request, in writing, any of the
- 3 information required to be maintained by the department under
- 4 paragraph (4) relating to an applicant's application. Upon
- 5 <u>receipt of the written request, the department shall provide</u>
- 6 the information to the applicant at no cost within 30 days.
- 7 (6) An applicant who is eligible for a refund of a fee
- 8 <u>under this section shall be refunded the fee amount within 30</u>
- 9 <u>days of the completed application being approved by the</u>
- 10 <u>department</u>.
- 11 (7) For an application approved or denied by the
- 12 <u>department, the department shall send a written notice to the</u>
- 13 <u>applicant regarding whether the department has complied with</u>
- 14 the requirements of this section and whether the applicant is
- 15 <u>eligible for a refund under this section.</u>
- 16 (b) Applicability.--
- 17 (1) Subsection (a) shall apply to applications submitted
- 18 to the department under Chapters 11 (relating to certificate
- 19 of title and security interests), 13 (relating to
- 20 registration of vehicles) and 15 (relating to licensing of
- 21 drivers).
- 22 (2) Subsection (a) shall not apply to applications
- related to apportioned registrations.
- 24 (c) Construction. -- A refund of an application fee under
- 25 subsection (a) shall not be construed to include a refund of a
- 26 tax owed to the Commonwealth.
- 27 (d) Appeal.--An applicant may appeal a denial of a refund by
- 28 the department under this section in accordance with 2 Pa.C.S.
- 29 Chs. 5 Subch. A (relating to practice and procedure of
- 30 Commonwealth agencies) and 7 Subch. A (relating to judicial

- 1 review of Commonwealth agency action).
- 2 (e) Report. -- Beginning one year after the effective date of
- 3 this section, and each year thereafter, the department shall
- 4 prepare and submit a report to the chairperson and minority
- 5 <u>chairperson of the Transportation Committee of the Senate and</u>
- 6 the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Transportation
- 7 Committee of the House of Representatives containing all of the
- 8 <u>following information for the previous 12-month period:</u>
- 9 <u>(1) The average processing time of applications</u>
- submitted to the department under Chapters 11, 13 and 15.
- 11 (2) The number of refunds provided to applicants under
- 12 <u>this section.</u>
- 13 (3) The average refund amount.
- 14 (4) The total amount of the refunds.
- 15 (5) Other information at the discretion of the
- 16 <u>department</u>.
- 17 (f) Posting of information. -- The department shall
- 18 conspicuously post on the department's publicly accessible
- 19 Internet website the following information:
- 20 (1) The eligibility of an applicant to receive a refund
- 21 <u>for an application not timely processed by the department</u>
- 22 under this section.
- 23 (2) The process for an applicant to request a refund
- 24 under this section.
- 25 (3) An explanation of an applicant's right to appeal a
- denial of refund under subsection (d).
- 27 (4) The process through which an applicant may request
- information regarding an application under subsection (a) (5).
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
